PEF at Winchburgh

At Winchburgh Primary School we are committed to continuously developing our approaches to ensuring equity for our pupils and tackling the poverty attainment gap. Our PEF Summary outlines how our PEF allocation is being used for universal and targeted interventions to support out pupils.

Approach

We ensure that our least advantaged pupils can access the whole curriculum through providing a range of resources and interventions that are suited to meeting their needs. To do this, pupils are met in groups to discuss their individual needs. As the year progresses, these interventions are reflected on and their impact assessed in order for them to be adopted, adapted, abandoned or amplified in line with the PEF plan.
